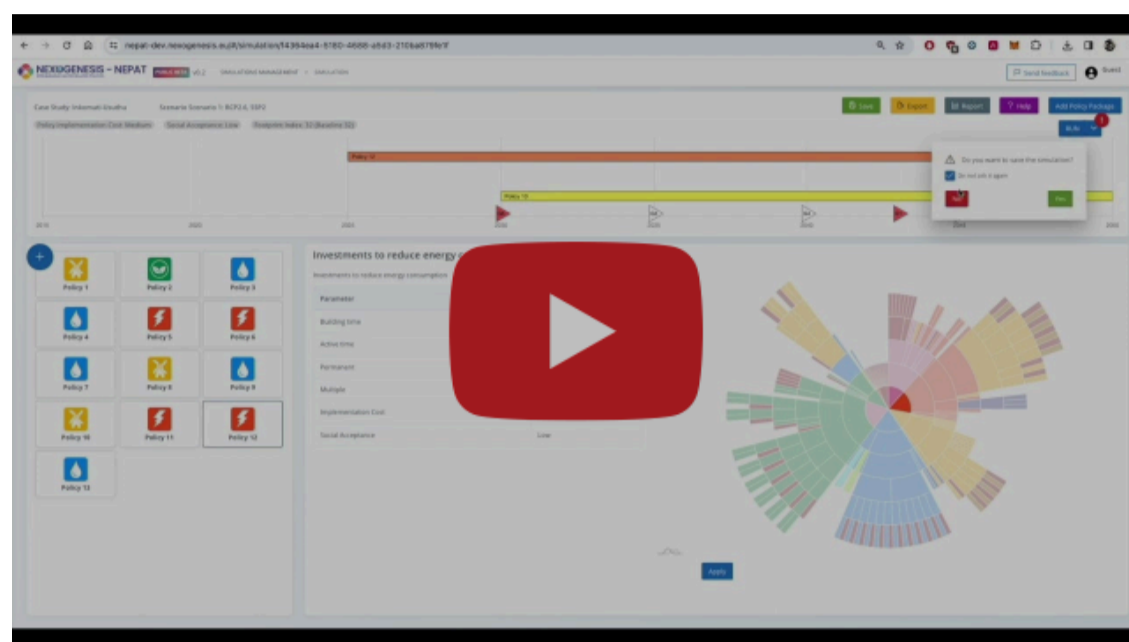

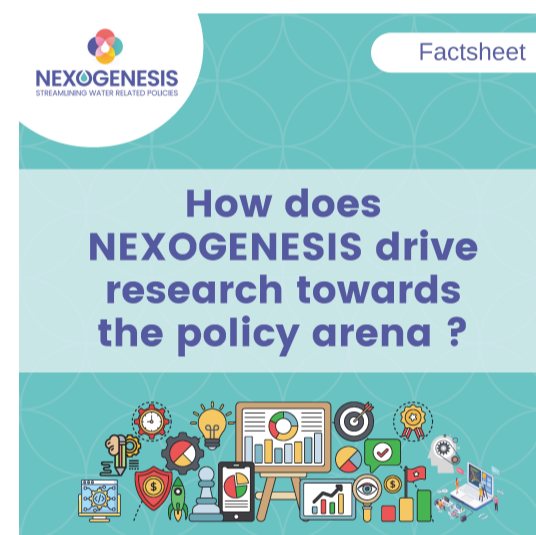


Case Study 2: 4th Stakeholder Workshop
